Jeannie goes straight to the phone just like George and Joan closed the front door, which implies that she is very kind, friendly, cheerful and rarely loses a smile—except to thaw Tom for "both the child", which she is doing specifically to annoy her. Jeannie and the child were seen in only two cartoons: Busy Buddies (1956) and Tot Watchers (1958). Jeannie is dubbed by Janet Waldo in the original shorts. The child also appears in Tom & Jerry Kids where the babysitter is slightly younger and a redhead instead of a blonde. The ants are an army of red ants who steal food as they see them. Mouse Wild a gray-green mouse, Shaggy outlet that occasionally replaces Jerry and leaking the enemies of him. Like Tom and Jerry, Wildmouse is by frank welker. first appears in the wildmooe episode and is last seen in the episode "re windmooe." moncy a puma that loves to torment spike and tyke. Wants to eat tyke lunch (and spike prevents him.) was expressed by frank welker. Sheriff potqut the senior sheriff of hokey swamp. He is arrogant, rude, and self-centered. threatened to send swampy back to the circus (which swampy is aware of the fact that it promotes cruelty on animals,) throwing swampy in tears. it also envy the swampy map that was in search of the hidden treasure. he appears in the episode "cajun gumbo," as the main antagonist of the episode. apart from the lonely episode in which he fought swampy, the sheriff and the gator brothers were also used as antagonists in an episode with wild mooes.
